Semper AB develops and provides nutrition and food for infants, and gluten-free food for consumers of all ages. Our mission is to delight consumers by conserving the goodness of nature. In line with our mission, we have set ourselves ambitious targets in respect to environmental, social and ethical responsibility. We want to offer healthy, nutritious, safe, and high quality products to our consumers, while protecting and respecting the planet we all share.

We do not test our products or raw materials on animals, nor do we fund, commission, sponsor, or otherwise support research which includes any type of animal testing. We also insist that our suppliers use alternatives to animal testing methods.

An exception is only made if demanded by regulatory authorities for safety or legislative purposes, or if the health and safety of infants has to be ensured and no other method is at our disposal. Semper has been working with nutritional research since 1938 and has long experience of working in close cooperation with scientists in the fields of nutrition and food technology. The collaboration with universities and well-reputed scientists is built upon a mutual respect for the addressed issues within the scientific field and therefore available methods.

Semper is committed to end animal testing. We will make every effort to further reduce the number of animal experimentation, including those legally required. We will continue to actively search for, promote and apply alternative methods and also share any new research that uses alternatives to animal testing.
